**Sign-in for Equestrian units** - Buchheim field behind R.O.P. on El Camino Real.

**Staging and Judging** - Buchheim field behind R.O.P. on El Camino Real.

Pre-Judging begins at 8:00 a.m. and ends **promptly** at 10:00 a.m. Entries that are not pre-judged are not eligible for awards. Final judging will occur during line of march.

**Awards** - Presented at Stone Field on the corner of La Zanja and Camino Capistrano approximately 30 minutes following the parade.

**Parking** - See enclosed map for parking instructions. Equestrian vehicles and trailers will need to be moved from Camino Capistrano by 3:30 pm.

**Insurance – Proof of insurance naming the San Juan Capistrano Fiesta Association as additional insured must be on file in order to ride in the parade!!**

Because of the traffic constraints we will strictly adhere to the street closures.

Due to the restriction imposed by our insurance carrier and the City of San Juan Capistrano, the following rules will be strictly enforced:

- **Rule # 8 – Alcoholic beverages and/or illegal substances are prohibited in the assembly area and parade route. Those participants under the influence of alcoholic beverages and/or illegal substances during the parade will be removed immediately.**
- **Rule # 10 – Discharging firearms, sirens, or other loud noises, along the parade route are prohibited by participants.**
- **Any participant who violates either rule will be immediately removed from the parade and will be prohibited from future participation.**

Due to the traffic constraints and the number of people in town, I urge you make every effort to arrive early.

We are continually striving to make the Parade better and to make your involvement with Swallows' Day Parade a good experience.
